

Notice of Conventions

The Republican Convention Process is your opportunity as a citizen to have input into the biennial platform of the Republican Party of Texas and the selection of those who lead the Party.

- If you want to participate in the **State Convention** held June 16-18, 2022 at the George R. Brown Convention Center, 1001 Avenida De Las Americas, Houston, you must be an elected delegate from your county. Senate District 28 in Wichita County is allocated 32 delegates and 32 alternates. Senate District 30 in Wichita County is allocated 16 delegates and 16 alternates.
- To be a delegate to the State Convention, you must first be a delegate to the **Senate District Conventions**, held Saturday, March 26, 2022 at 8:00 AM at Barwise Middle School, 3807 Kemp. At this convention resolutions will be considered and delegates to the State Convention will be elected from Senate Districts 28 and 30.
- To be a delegate to the **Senate District Conventions**, you must be elected as a delegate from your Precinct, in **Precinct Conventions** that begins on Saturday, March 5th at 11 AM. at the following locations:

At these conventions, resolutions will be considered and delegates to the Senate District Conventions will be elected.
